City of Mulberry, Arkansas will receive sealed bids on a General Contract for removal and replacement of existing asphalt, gravel, curbs, gutters, and sidewalks. It includes construction of drop inlets, installation of handicap ramps, street sign relocation, reinforced concrete pipe, sidewalks, cleanup, and other work and materials required to complete the project.

Bids shall be on a unit price basis.

City of Mulberry, Arkansas will receive Bids until **10:00am** Local Time on **July 5, 2017** at City Hall, 207 N. Main Street, Mulberry, Arkansas. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud immediately after specified closing time. All interested parties are invited to attend.

Pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. ' 22-9-203, the Owner encourages all small, minority, and women business enterprises to submit bids for capital improvements. Encouragement is also made to all general contractors that in the event they subcontract portions of their work, consideration is given to the identified groups.

The City of Mulberry hereby notifies all bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions, wage rate laws and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Acts of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply.

Copies of the Bidding documents may be obtained at Southern Reprographics in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders for the sum of **\$100.00** for each set of documents. Return of documents is not required, and amount paid for documents is not refundable. Partial sets are not available.

Each Bid must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond executed on the prescribed form, payable to the City of Mulberry, Arkansas in an amount not less than 5 percent of the amount bid. The bid proposal and work of the proposed contract shall be in accordance with all applicable federal, state, county, and local laws, ordinances and regulations.

The Attention of the Bidder is directed to the applicable federal and state requirements and conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under this contract. The contractor's license shall be provided at the time the contract is executed.

Any Bid may be rejected which contains material omissions, or irregularities, or in which any of the unit prices are obviously unbalanced in the opinion of the Owner. Also, a bid may be rejected if it, in any manner, shall fail to conform to the conditions of the Bidding Requirements and Contract Documents.

The Owner reserves the right to waive irregularities, reject bids, choose the most qualified bidder for the Project, and to postpone award of the Contract for a period of time which shall not exceed beyond 90 days from the bid opening date.

Buy America provisions apply to this project. The AHTD Standard Specifications Section 100 has requirements and restrictions for Buy America. Also, 23 CFR Sec. 635.410 has all the federal requirements for Buy America.
